Treasurer's report

The financial statements for the reporting period (year to 31 March 2019) show that the club made a deficit for the first time in our history of £264 compared to a surplus of £787 in the previous year. Based on this surplus club funds are £3,881.

The deficit has arisen due to several factors including;

- £420 external timing at the Grocontinental Relay
- Investment in 3 new coaches
- Charity donations to Guide Dogs and the Air Ambulance

The committee are comfortable with the level of expenditure and have further investment in new coaches planned for the coming year.

The club still have snoods in stock but took the decision, after the disappointing experience with Run Geek as kit suppliers, to give club members Mandy Lewis and Ed Vine the opportunity to provide kit to order and this seems to be working really. Many thanks to both of you!

A detailed breakdown of the Income and Expenditure and Balance Sheet for the year ended 31 March 2019 and budget for 2020 will be put on the website in due course.

Looking forward to the coming year.....

We are putting on our relay at Alderford Lake in July and are using the chip timing that was used at the race put on by Oswestry Olympians, this should help the race go smoother and remove a lot of the stress on the evening for the organising committee.

As stated above, we are continuing to invest in new coaches, this is down to the fact that the club is in such a strong state and membership is growing at a fantastic rate.
